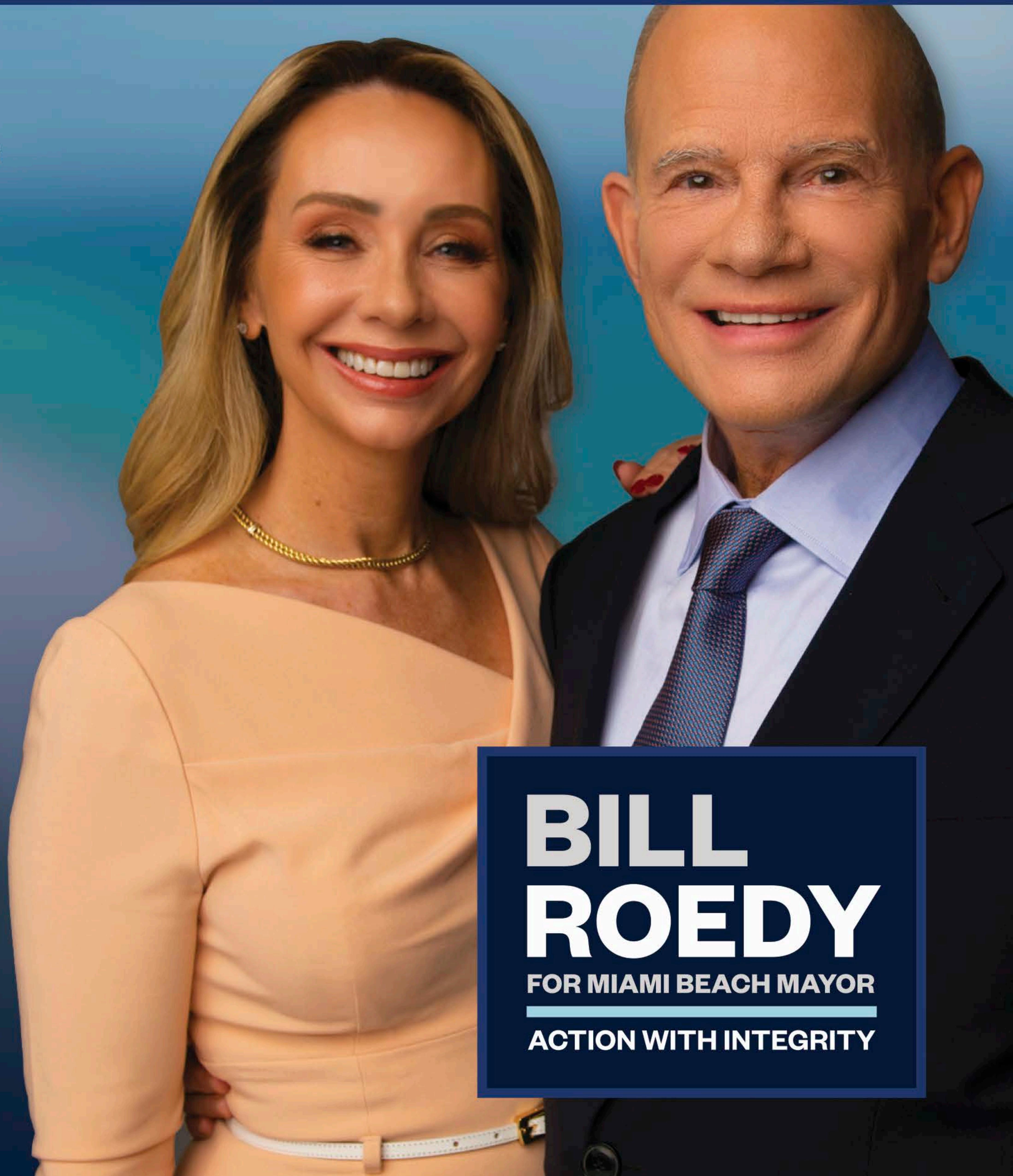

VOTE BY MAIL

Due to recent changes in Florida law, all requests for vote-by-mail ballots expired at the end of 2022. Any request on file has expired. If you want to continue voting by mail, please submit your request today.

If you are presently registered to vote in Miami-Dade County you may request a vote-by-mail ballot online, email, fax, phone or mail.

LAST DAY TO REQUEST A VOTE BY MAIL BALLOT IS OCT 26TH BY 5PM

Mail Ballots Must Be Returned As Follows:

1. **BY MAIL**- A Vote-by-Mail ballot may be returned via the United States Postal Service and must be received by 7 p.m. on Nov. 7 Election Day
2. **DROPPED OFF** at any Early Voting location during the hours of operation via Secure Ballot Intake Station (Vote-by-Mail Drop Box).
3. **IN PERSON** on Election Day before 7 p.m.

SAMPLE BALLOT

VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

When voting in person, whether at an early voting site or at a polling place on Election Day, photo identification is required.

Voters must bring a current and valid identification that contains their name, photograph, and signature (if a voter does not have (1) ID with a picture and signature, then they must provide a picture ID and signature ID.
